### **YWCA INTERIM HOUSE**

Provides shelter to women survivors of domestic violence/sexual assault and their children. Services include a 67 bed shelter, 24 hour crisis line, individual and group counseling, support groups, legal advocacy, sexual assault advocacy, child care services, volunteer training, non-residential programs and support groups, community education and referrals for housing, legal services, medical assistance, transportation and financial assistance.

#### **REQUIREMENTS**

**ELIGIBILITY:** Women age 18 and older who have been physically, emotionally or sexually assaulted and their minor children

**APPLICATION PROCESS:** Call the crisis line at 313-861-5300

**REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:** No documentation required

**FEES:** No fees

## **SUNSHINE ALWAYS BRIGHTER WITH A 2ND CHANCE MINISTRIES**

Provides a residential program with a domestic violence shelter that assists with housing, continuing education, workshops, parenting skills, abuse issues(substance and/or physical), self esteem and more.

#### **REQUIREMENTS**

**ELIGIBILITY:** Young ladies from the ages of 18-23 years of age with one or two children who are ready to make a change in their life

**APPLICATION PROCESS:** - Due to limited space potential residents must be interviewed before acceptance into program - Call for interview

**REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:** - Government issued photo identification - Birth certificate for mother and child(ren) - Will not disqualify based on lack of documentation

**FEES:** No fees

**AREA SERVED:** Macomb, Oakland and Wayne Counties

**FIRST STEP: WESTERN AND DOWNRIVER WAYNE COUNTY PROJECT ON DOMESTIC AND SEXUAL VIOLENCE - WAYNE OFFICE**

Provides emergency, short term shelter for victims of domestic and/or sexual violence and their children. Shelter services include individual and group counseling, safety planning, medical attention, housing referrals, and educational and recreational activities for children. Shelter location is confidential.

**REQUIREMENTS**

**ELIGIBILITY:** - Adult victims (male and female) of sexual assault or domestic violence and their minor children - No restriction on age or number of children - Serves Wayne County primarily, but accepts victims of other areas if needed and beds are available

**APPLICATION PROCESS:** Call to check bed availability and get shelter location

**REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:** Requests government issued photo identification, if available

**FEES:** No fees

**AREA SERVED:** Wayne County

**SERVICE HOURS:** Mon-Sun 24 hours
