COALITION ON TEMPORARY SHELTER - PEGGY'S PLACE

Provides shelter to families referred by the CAM. There is capacity for 120 individuals. Housing Specialists and Mobility Coaches are assigned to every guest to ensure that their needs are being met as well as to address the issues that brought them into the shelter. Family workers assist with school registration, transportation and obtaining housing. Outreach is provided up to five years for those families that are engaged with the Coaching methodology. COTS employs the Passport To Self-sufficiency which deals with five domains: Housing, Financial Literacy, Education, Health and Well-Being, Career Development. Following this track, COTS is determined to assist each participate in breaking the bonds of poverty.

REQUIREMENTS

ALTERNATIVES FOR GIRLS

Provides emergency and transitional shelter for at risk girls and young women and their children. Houses up to 35 young women and 10 of their children at any given time. Two residents share a room. In the family wing, mother and child reside together. Young women in residence beyond two weeks must enter the Transition to Independent Living (TIL) Program. TIL requires residents to be enrolled in an education program; to engage in counseling to address personal and family issues and challenges; to prepare for, seek and obtain employment; and to participate in life skills programming.

REQUIREMENTS

ELIGIBILITY: - At risk girls and women age 15 to 21 1/2 and their children- Cannot be a juvenile justice or foster care ward

APPLICATION PROCESS: - Must present in person at Southwest Solutions at 1600 Porter to be assessed during CAM hours (Mon-Fri 11am-7pm)- After hours call 313-305-0311

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS: - Michigan photo ID (school ID or driver's license preferred)- Minors must be signed in by parent/guardian

REQUIREMENTS

ELIGIBILITY: Residents must be able and willing to seek stable housing and employment. May be required to apply for assistance through the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS: - Government issued photo identification - May be required to provide birth certificates or Social Security cards for all family members - Some programs will require proof of previous residency
